## Kiwis play Newcastle next Sunday

The touring New Zealand team visit Newcastle next weekend and will play our representative team at the International Sports Centre on Sunday at 3.00 p.m.

This will be the 18th occasion that the "Kiwis" have played Newcastle. In the previous 17 games Newcastle have only defeated them on four occasions. However, Newcastle have been successful in two out of the last three. In 1978 they won 19-12, in 1967 they again were winners 14-7 and in 1963 went down 24 points to six.

Between 1908 and 1920 New Zealand played Newcastle on six occasions and won the six games.

Newcastle's record against international sides is very good and all touring sides respect the ability of our players by fielding their strongest teams and it will be surprising if the New Zealanders are not at full strength for this match.
