Whilst the Newcastle Rugby Football League is desirous of charging 1/6, plus 3d. tax to the Outer Enclosure and 2/-. plus 4d. tax to the Grandstand Direct on the Newcastle Sports Ground, New Lambton, Waratah and Wickham Ovals, it has been compelled by the Newcastle City Council to add a surcharge of 2d.

This alters the tax scale—therefore the admission charges will be to the Outer Ground, 1/6, plus 2d. Council surcharge, plus 4d. tax, total 2/-. To the Grandstand Direct, 2/-. plus 2d. Council surcharge, plus 5d. tax, total 2/7.
