Teddy Dillon who was playing really well, was again unlucky to suffer injury that will keep him out for a game or two.

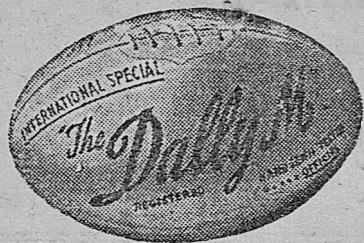
