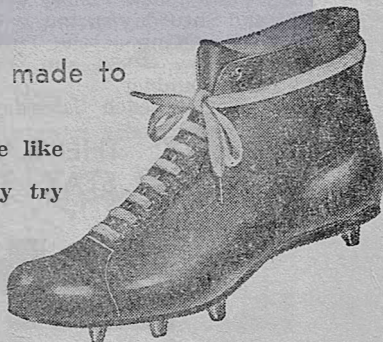
Pleasing to see Ian Greedy playing for Maitland again. Ian should soon win a place in the higher grade.
